1. As a noun it is a sacred song or verse sung or recited in Jewish and Christian worship.
2. Synonyms for psalms are reverent poems, songs of praise
3. As a proper noun it is a collection of psalms in the Bible, called the Book of Psalms also used in Christian and Jewish worship. *For example Psalm 23 says "the Lord is my shepherd; I shall not fear."*

1. extreme anger (chiefly used for humorous or rhetorical effect).
"he hid his pipe for fear of incurring his father's wrath"
2. Synonyms for wrath are anger, rage, fury, outrage, vexation, annoyance, irritation, crossness, displeasure
3. Use over time for: **wrath**
